### What is the Virtual Expungement Clinic?

The Virtual Expungement Clinic is a volunteer lawyer partnership program between Legal Aid Services of Oregon and Intel. Volunteer lawyers provide FREE consultations to those who may be eligible for expungement. Attorneys review the records and assist with filling out the necessary paperwork for offenses committed in Oregon.

All consultations are conducted over the phone and documents are mailed to you.



*Collateral sanctions of a criminal record can negatively impact your employment, housing, and education prospects.*

### What Does Expungement Do?

If an expungement is granted, your conviction or arrest is sealed and you are deemed to not have been previously convicted or arrested.

### About Legal Aid Services of Oregon (LASO)

LASO is a non-profit law firm that provides services to low-income Oregonians in civil (non-criminal) matters - housing, eviction, foreclosure, elder abuse, guardianship, care giving, Medicaid/Medicare, family law, and bankruptcy.

There is no charge for legal services at LASO, but most clients must be eligible under the federal poverty income guidelines. LASO is able to provide free legal assistance due in part to federal and state grants. Due to limited resources, we are unable to provide legal assistance to all eligible individuals. We accept cases based upon the availability of staff, the strength of your case, and whether or not your case aligns with our office's current priorities. We also partner with local attorneys who accept a limited number of cases *pro bono*, or free of charge. If you need help from Legal Aid, call 503-224-4086.
