The clinic is a volunteer attorney project in partnership with the Clackamas County Bar, Clackamas Law Library and Legal Aid Services of Oregon (LASO).

Have you ever been denied a job, due to prior conviction? Have you been denied housing because of an arrest? We may be able to help clean up your criminal record.

Volunteer attorneys provide FREE consultations to people interested in clearing their criminal record. Attorneys review criminal records to determine eligibility for an expungement. If eligible, attorneys assist with filling out the necessary paperwork to clear Oregon records.

What Does Expungement Do?

If an expungement is granted, your conviction or arrest is sealed and you are deemed to not have been previously convicted or arrested.
