- 1. Fill out the notice on page 2.
- 2. Make a copy of the notice for your records.
- 3. Deliver the notice to your park manager or owner using one of these methods:
 - a. **Personal delivery**: Hand a copy of the notice to the manager or owner.
 - b. Mail: Mail a copy by first-class, regular USPS mail.
 - c. **Email:** If your lease agreement allows you to serve notices by email, email a copy of the notice to the email address listed in your rental agreement.
